An Act for Granting to His Majesty Certain Sums of Money for the Public Service for the Fiscal Years Ending Respectively the Thirty-first Day of March, 1935, the Thirty-first Day of March, 1936, and the Thirty-first Day of March, 1937.

Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from His Honour, W. L. Walsh, Lieutenant Governor of the Province of Alberta, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta, not otherwise provided for, during the financial periods ending respectively the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, and the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, and for other purposes relating thereto:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Appropriation Act, 1936."
- 2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole four hundred and ninety-six thousand, three hundred and ninety-one dollars and twenty-six cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-four to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule A to this Act.
- 3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole four million, two hundred and seventy thousand, seven hundred dollars and three cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule B to this Act.

- 4. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole twenty-four million, five hundred and twenty-eight thousand, nine hundred and forty-six dollars and fifty-seven cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule C to this Act.
- **5.** The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.
- **6.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
