A BILL TO AMEND THE LABOUR DISPUTES ACT.

An Act to amend The Labour Disputes Act.

(Assented to _____, 1936.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Labour Disputes Act Amendment Act, 1936.*"

2. *The Labour Disputes Act*, being chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1926, is hereby amended as to section 2 thereof,—

(a) by striking out paragraph (a) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

"(a) 'Minister' shall mean the member of the Executive Council for the time being charged with the administration of this Act";

(b) by striking out paragraph (b) thereof.

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 16 thereof by striking out the word "Department", where the same occurs therein, and by substituting therefor the word "Minister".

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
