This Bill amends the definition of holiday so as to include Remembrance Day, the day after Christmas Day, and any day appointed by proclamation of the Governor General in Council or by proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council for a public holiday or for a fast or thanksgiving or as a day of public mourning.

An Act to amend the Interpretation Act.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Interpretation Act Amendment Act, 1936."
- 2. The Interpretation Act, being chapter 1 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 36 thereof by striking out paragraph (h) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

 "(h) 'Holiday' shall include Sunday, New Year's Day, Ash Wednesday, Good Friday, Easter Monday, the twenty-fourth day of May or, when such day falls on a Sunday, the twenty-fifth day of May to be known as Victoria Day, Dominion Day, Labour Day, Remembrance Day, Christmas Day, the twenty-sixth day of December or, when such day falls on a Sunday, the twenty-seventh day of December, any day appointed by proclamation of the Governor General in Council or by proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council for a public holiday or for a fast or thanksgiving or as a day of public mourning, and with reference to any particular part of the Province such day in each year as may by proclamation of the Lieutenant gear as may by proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council be appointed as a public holiday for such part of the Province for the planting of forest or other trees."
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
