An Act to amend The Seizures Act.

(Assented to _____, 1936.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Seizures Act Amendment Act, 1936.*"
- 2.** *The Seizures Act*, being chapter 16 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1933, is hereby amended as to section 3 by adding at the end thereof the words "nor to seizures made under the provisions of *The Stallion Enrolment Act, 1924.*"
- 3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
