A BILL TO AMEND THE DOMESTIC ANIMALS ACT
(MUNICIPALITIES).

NOTE.

This Bill clarifies the existing provision as to the fees payable to the poundkeeper for notices and other services in connection therewith and prescribes an inclusive fee of \$1.00 as to all animals impounded at one seizure.

An Act to amend The Domestic Animals Act
(Municipalities).

(Assented to _____, 1936.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Domestic Animals Act (Municipalities) Amendment Act, 1936.*"

2. *The Domestic Animals Act (Municipalities)*, being chapter 25 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1923, is hereby amended as to section 42 thereof by striking out paragraph (e) of subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

"(e) To the poundkeeper for making out notices and all necessary copies thereof and all services in connection therewith other than those for which a fee is elsewhere expressly provided, for each notice (which shall include all animals impounded at one seizure) one dollar."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
