# BILL

No. 33 of 1936.

An Act to amend The Rural Mutual Telephone Companies Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1936.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Rural Mutual Telephone Companies Act Amendment Act, 1936.*"

**2.** *The Rural Mutual Telephone Companies Act*, being chapter 48 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1935, is hereby amended as to section 3 thereof by striking out subsection (2) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:  
“(2) Every order made pursuant to this section shall take effect as and from the making thereof.”

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
