A BILL TO AMEND THE OFFICIAL GUARDIAN ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill requires the Official Guardian to act as the guardian of the estate only of an infant who is a ward of the court or pursuant to an order of the court. As the Act now stands he is required to act as the guardian of the person and estate of such infant.

An Act to amend The Official Guardian Act.

(Assented to _____, 1936.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Official Guardian Act Amendment Act, 1936.*"

2. *The Official Guardian Act*, being chapter 22 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 4 thereof by striking out paragraph (e) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

"(e) act as guardian of the estate of any infant made a ward of the court under *The Children's Protection Act*, or as guardian of the estate of any infant upon order of the court;"

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
