A BILL TO AMEND THE TIMBER AREAS TAX ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill amends the definition of Minister and provides that distresses for the collection of the taxes imposed by the Act may be made by any person authorized by the Minister in writing for that purpose. As the Act stands the only person who may levy such a distress is a sheriff.

# BILL

No. 39 of 1936.

An Act to amend The Timber Areas Tax Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1936.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Timber Areas Tax Act Amendment Act, 1936.*"

**2.** *The Timber Areas Tax Act*, being chapter 35 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 2 thereof by striking out paragraph (a) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

"(a) 'Minister' means the member of the Executive Council for the time being charged with the administration of this Act;".

**3.** The said Act is further amended as to section 8 thereof by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:

"8. Any taxes imposed by this Act which are in arrear may be levied and collected at any time after the same become in arrear by distress and sale of any of the goods and chattels of the person liable for the payment thereof; and any person authorized by the Minister in writing to levy any such distress is hereby authorized to distrain upon and sell so much of such goods and chattels as will produce a sum sufficient to satisfy the arrears of taxes and the costs of distress and sale."

**4.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
