An Act to amend The Minimum Wage Act, 1925.

(Assented to _____, 1936.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Minimum Wage Act, 1925, Amendment Act, 1936.*"

2. *The Minimum Wage Act, 1925*, being chapter 23 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1925, is hereby amended as to section 2 thereof by striking out paragraph (g) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

"(g) 'Minister' shall mean the member of the Executive Council for the time being charged with the administration of this Act;".

3. This Act shall come into force upon a date to be fixed by Proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
