#### Bill No. 47 of 1936.

A BILL TO AMEND THE PUBLIC UTILITIES ACT, 1923, AND TO CONTINUE IN FORCE CERTAIN PROVISIONS THEREOF.

#### NOTE.

Section 2 of this Bill provides for the appointment of temporary members of the Board at times during which the Board consists of the chairman alone.

Section 3 continues in force for another year certain provisions relating to the control of milk which would otherwise expire on the thirtieth of June, 1936.

# BILL

An Act to amend The Public Utilities Act, 1923, and to continue in Force certain Provisions thereof.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1936."
- **2.** The Public Utilities Act, being chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1923, is hereby amended by inserting therein, immediately after section 3 thereof, the following new section:
- new section:

  "3a. At any time during which the Board consists of the chairman thereof and no others, the Lieutenant Governor in Council, upon the request of that member, may appoint a fit and proper person as a temporary member of the Board or a substitute for a temporary member to act during the illness or absence of such temporary member for such period, upon such terms and at such remuneration as may be prescribed by order in council, and it shall be the duty of any person so appointed to assist the chairman in the discharge of the powers and duties of the Board, and in the performance of such duty the person so appointed shall have all the powers and authority which are by this Act conferred upon a member of the Board appointed pursuant to section 3
- 3. The provisions of *The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1933,* as amended by *The Public Utilities Act, 1933, Amendment Act, 1934,* and *The Public Utilities Act, 1934, Amendment Act, 1935,* shall continue in force from and after the thirtieth day of June, 1936, until the first day of July, 1937.
- 4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
