A BILL TO AMEND THE JUDICATURE ACT.

NOTE.

Section 2 of this Bill provides for the appointment of a Clerk or Deputy Clerk of the Court in each judicial or subjudicial district as the public administrator of such district and does away with the provision permitting the appointment of trust companies as public administrators.

The amendment made by section 3 provides that the amount of the security required in the case of a public administrator shall be such amount as may be required by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

The amendment made by section 4 provides for filing of affidavits leading to administration of estates by a public administrator in subjudicial districts as well as in judicial districts.

An Act to amend The Judicature Act.

 \mathbf{H}^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Judicature Act Amendment Act, 1936."

2. The Judicature Act, being chapter 72 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 46 thereof by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following: "46. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint

"46. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may appoint the Clerk or Deputy Clerk of the Court in each judicial district or subjudicial district in the Province to be a public administrator for such judicial district or subjudicial district."

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 49 thereof by striking out the words "in the penal sum of twenty thousand dollars, or more," where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof.

4. The said Act is further amended as to section 51 thereof by striking out the words "with the Clerk or Deputy Clerk of the Judicial District", where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof, and by substituting therefor the words "in the office of the Clerk or Deputy Clerk in the judicial district or subjudicial district".

5. This Act shall come into force upon a date to be fixed by Proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
