A BILL TO AMEND THE CHIROPRACTIC ACT.

NOTE.

The amendment made by this Bill provides that the Advisory Board of Examiners shall consist of five persons of whom four shall be residents of the Province and graduates of a School of Chiropractic and the other a layman: as the Act now stands two members are required to be residents of the Province and graduates of a School of Chiropractic, two members are to be members of the Faculty of Medicine of the University, and the remaining member may be any person.

 \mathbf{H}^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Chiropractic Act Amendment Act, 1936."

2. The Chiropractic Act, being chapter 58 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1923, is hereby amended as to section 4 thereof by striking out subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

by striking out subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the following: "4.—(1) There shall be constituted an Advisory Board of Examiners consisting of five members to be appointed by the Minister of whom four shall be persons resident in the Province and graduates of a School of Chiropractic which requires for its course of instruction not less than eighteen months resident study within a period not exceeding three years, and one member a layman who will act as chairman of the board: "Provided that if the Minister is unable to constitute the

"Provided that if the Minister is unable to constitute the board according to the foregoing provisions hereof or if any of the persons appointed by him in pursuance hereof refuse or neglect to act, the remaining members shall constitute the board for all purposes."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
