**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Companies Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1936."
- 2. The Companies Act, 1929, being chapter 14 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended as to section 65 thereof by striking out subsection (2) thereof.
- 3. This  $\mbox{Act\ shall\ come\ into\ force\ on\ the\ day\ upon\ which\ it\ is\ assented\ to.}$
