HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Companies Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1936.*"

2. *The Companies Act, 1929*, being chapter 14 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended as to section 65 thereof by striking out subsection (2) thereof.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
