An Act to amend The Land Titles Act.

(Assented to _____, 1936.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Land Titles Act Amendment Act, 1936.*"

2. *The Land Titles Act*, being chapter 133 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection:

"(4) Any mortgage or encumbrance providing for the delivery to the mortgagee or encumbrancee of grain shall be registerable in the same manner as any other mortgage or encumbrance, provided that there is set out therein the amount of grain of any specified description and grade as being the amount of grain deliverable pursuant thereto, and all the provisions of this Act relating to such other mortgages or encumbrances shall, *mutatis mutandis*, apply to any mortgage or encumbrance to which this subsection relates."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
