HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Licensing of Trades and Businesses Act Amendment Act, 1936."
- 2. The Licensing of Trades and Businesses Act, being chapter 67 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1936, is hereby amended as to section 5 thereof by striking out the words "or The Industrial Standards Act", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "The Industrial Standards Act or The Hours of Work Act".
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
