An Act to amend the Law respecting the Supreme Court
and the Administration of Justice.

(Assented to _____, 1936.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,
enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Judicature Act Amendment Act, 1936.*"

2. *The Judicature Act*, being chapter 72 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 37 thereof by inserting therein immediately after paragraph (o) thereof the following new paragraphs:

"(p) Notwithstanding any Act, law or rule to the contrary, the Crown may sue and be sued, implead and be impleaded in any cause or matter whatsoever, in any of the courts of the Province;

"(q) All such suits brought by or against the Crown may be commenced and carried on under the usual rules of practice in such courts, as the same exist from time to time."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
