HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Legislative Assembly Act Amendment Act, 1936."
- 2. The Legislative Assembly Act, being chapter 3 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 11 thereof by striking out the words "is to be paid", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "has been paid to and accepted by any such person".
- ${\bf 3.}$ This Act shall be retroactive to the first day of September, 1935.
- $\ensuremath{\textbf{4.}}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
