

# BILL

No. 18 of 1936 (Second Session).

An Act to amend The Teaching Profession Act, 1935.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1936.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Teaching Profession Act, 1935, Amendment Act, 1936, (No. 2).*"

**2.** *The Teaching Profession Act, 1935*, being chapter 81 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1935, is hereby amended as to section 4 thereof by striking out the words "shall as a condition of their employment, be members of the Association." where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the words "shall as a condition of their employment or continued employment, be members of the Association."

**3.** The said Act is further amended as to section 10 thereof by striking out the words "such teacher" where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the words "each and every teacher".

**4.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times since the third day of April, 1936.
