 \mathbf{H}^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Judicature Act Amendment Act, 1936."

2. The Judicature Act, being chapter 72 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended by inserting therein, immediately after section 27 thereof, the following new sections:

"27a. No action shall be brought or maintained against any member of the Executive Council of the Province whereby relief of any kind is claimed on account of anything done or proposed to be done or omitted to be done by him in the execution of his office unless permission to bring or maintain such action has first been given by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

"27b. No action shall be brought or maintained whereby the relief claimed or part of the relief claimed is an injunction, mandamus, prohibition or other process or proceeding affecting or interfering directly or indirectly with the doing by any person or the omission by any person to do any act authorized or directed by a statute of the Legislature of the Province or by an Order in Council of the Province heretofore or hereafter passed or made, unless permission to bring or maintain such action has first been given by the Lieutenant Governor in Council.

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
