No. 8 of 1937.

An Act for Granting to His Majesty Certain Sums of Money for the Public Service for the Fiscal Years Ending Respectively the Thirty-first Day of March, 1936, the Thirty-first Day of March, 1937, and the Thirty-first Day of March, 1938.

(Assented to _____, 1937.)

Most Gracious Sovereign:

WHEREAS it appears by Messages from the Honourable, the Administrator of the Government of the Province of Alberta, Horace Harvey, and the Estimates accompanying the said Messages, that the sums hereinafter mentioned are required to defray certain expenses of the Public Service of Alberta, not otherwise provided for, during the financial periods ending respectively the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, and the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, and for other purposes relating thereto:

May it therefore please Your Majesty that it may be enacted, and be it enacted by the King's Most Excellent Majesty, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Appropriation Act, No. 2, 1937.*"

2. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole six hundred and twelve thousand, three hundred and sixty-three dollars and thirty-five cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-five to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule A to this Act.

3. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole three million, six hundred and six thousand, nine hundred and eight dollars and fifty-six cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from

the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-six to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven, not otherwise provided for and set forth in Schedule B to this Act.

4. From and out of the General Revenue Fund there may be paid and applied a sum not exceeding in the whole sixteen million, nine hundred and thirty-five thousand, two hundred and twenty-five dollars and seventy cents towards defraying the several charges and expenses of the Public Service from the first day of April, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-seven to the thirty-first day of March, one thousand nine hundred and thirty-eight, not otherwise provided for, and being the amount of each of the items to be voted, set forth in Schedule C to this Act, less the amounts voted on account for the said items in "*The Appropriation Act, No. 1, 1937*," passed at the present session of the Legislative Assembly.

5. The due application of all moneys expended under this Act shall be accounted for.

6. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
