HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Auctioneers and Pedlers' Act Repeal Act."
- 2. The Auctioneers and Pedlers' Act, being chapter 39 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby repealed.
- 3. This Act shall come into force upon a date to be fixed by Proclamation of the Lieutenant Governor in Council.
