A BILL TO AMEND THE INDUSTRIAL STANDARDS
ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill makes amendments of a minor nature consequent upon the doing away with the Bureau of Labour, and confers on the Board of Industrial Relations the powers and duties originally conferred upon the Bureau of Labour.

By section 4 wilful default in complying with any order of the Board is made an offence punishable by a fine and in default of payment by imprisonment.

BILL

An Act to amend The Industrial Standards Act.

(Assented to _____, 1937.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Industrial Standards Act Amendment Act, 1937.*"

2. *The Industrial Standards Act*, being chapter 47 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1935, is hereby amended as to section 2,—

(a) by striking out paragraph (b) thereof and by substituting therefor the following:

"(b) 'Board' means The Board of Industrial Relations constituted pursuant to *The Hours of Work Act*;"

(b) by striking out paragraph (c).

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 6 thereof by striking out the words "The Bureau of Labour" and by substituting therefor the words "The Board".

4. The said Act is further amended as to section 13,—

(a) by striking out the words "the Commissioner of Labour" wherever the same occur therein and by substituting therefor the words "the Board"; and

(b) by adding thereto the following new subsection:
"(2) Every person who wilfully makes default in complying with any requirement of the Board made pursuant to this section, shall be guilty of an offence and liable on summary conviction to a penalty of not more than thirty dollars and costs and in default of payment to imprisonment of not more than one month."

5. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
