A BILL TO AMEND THE SUCCESSION DUTY ACT, 1934.

An Act to amend The Succession Duty Act, 1934.

(Assented to _____, 1937.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Succession Duty Act, 1934, Amendment Act, 1937.*"

2. *The Succession Duty Act, 1934*, being chapter 17 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1934, is hereby amended as to section 10 thereof by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:

"**10.** Where the net value of the property wheresoever situated, both within and without the Province passing,—

"(a) to any person mentioned in the second or third column of the table exceeds fifty thousand dollars; or

"(b) to any person mentioned in the fourth column of the table exceeds twenty-five thousands dollars—

in each case additional duty shall be payable on the dutiable value of the property passing to such person at the appropriate date prescribed in Table B in the Schedule to this Act."

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 13 thereof by striking out the same and by substituting therefor the following:

"**13.** Where the net value of the property wheresoever situated, both within and without the Province passing,—

"(a) to any person mentioned in the second or third column of the table exceeds fifty thousand dollars; or

"(b) to any person mentioned in the fourth column of the table exceeds twenty-five thousand dollars,—

in each case additional duty shall be payable on the dutiable value of the property passing to such person at the appropriate date prescribed in Table B in the Schedule to this Act."

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
