## A BILL TO AMEND THE PUBLIC UTILITIES ACT, 1923.

This Bill strikes out a provision with regard to the subdivision of land, which is inserted by another Bill in *The Town Planning Act, 1929.* 

It also continues in force for another year sections 51a and 51b of the Act relating to the marketing of fluid milk and cream and other food products.

# BILL

#### No. 27 of 1937.

An Act to amend The Public Utilities Act, 1923.

#### (Assented to , 1937.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1937."

2. The Public Utilities Act, 1923, being chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1923, is hereby amended by striking out section 142b.

**3.** The provisions of The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1933, as amended by The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1934, and The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1935, and The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1936, shall continue in force from and after the thirtieth day of June, 1937, until the first day of July, 1938.

 $\ensuremath{\textbf{4.}}$  This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
