# BILL

No. 27 of 1937.

An Act to amend The Public Utilities Act, 1923.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1937.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1937.*"

**2.** *The Public Utilities Act, 1923*, being chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1923, is hereby amended by striking out section 142*b*.

**3.** The provisions of *The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1933*, as amended by *The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1934*, and *The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1935*, and *The Public Utilities Act, 1923, Amendment Act, 1936*, shall continue in force from and after the thirtieth day of June, 1937, until the first day of July, 1938.

**4.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
