A BILL TO AMEND THE MUNICIPAL HOSPITALS
ACT, 1929.

NOTE.

This Bill makes provision for the appointment by the Minister of members of a hospital board to represent a municipality whose affairs are under the administration of a public administrator, pursuant to The Department of Municipal Affairs Act.

An Act to amend The Municipal Hospitals Act, 1929.

(Assented to _____, 1937.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Municipal Hospitals Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1937.*"

2. *The Municipal Hospitals Act, 1929*, being chapter 33 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after section 31 the following new section:

"**31a.** In the case of any municipality the council of which has been dismissed and an official administrator has been appointed in its place, pursuant to any provision of *The Department of Municipal Affairs Act*, the member of the Board to represent such municipality shall be appointed by the Minister; in the case of all other municipalities, the member of the Board for such municipality shall be elected in the manner prescribed by sections 32 to 43 both inclusive."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
