The effect of the amendment made by this Act is to exclude an addict as defined in the Act from the operation of section 3, which provides for proceedings before a Justice leading to an inquiry as to persons who are mentally diseased and dangerous to be at large.

# BILL

No. 43 of 1937.

An Act to amend The Mental Diseases Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1937.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Mental Diseases Act Amendment Act, 1937.*"

**2.** *The Mental Diseases Act*, being chapter 223 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 3 by striking out the words "or is an addict" where the same occur therein.

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
