A BILL TO AMEND THE RAILWAY TAXATION ACT
(PROVINCIAL).

This Bill increases the rate of taxation on the assessed value of railways from one per cent to one and three-quarters per cent.

An Act to amend The Railway Taxation Act (Provincial).

(Assented to _____, 1937.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Railway Taxation Act (Provincial) Amendment Act, 1937.*"

2. *The Railway Taxation Act (Provincial)*, being chapter 36 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 11, by striking out the words "one per cent" where the same occur therein and by substituting therefor the words "one and three-quarters per centum".

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
