An Act to amend The Legislative Assembly Act.

(Assented to _____, 1937.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Legislative Assembly Act Amendment Act, 1937.*"

2. *The Legislative Assembly Act*, being chapter 3 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 11 by adding at the end thereof the following new subsection:

"(2) This section shall not apply to any contract or agreement under which any goods are sold or delivered to any person who is in receipt of indigent or unemployment relief, notwithstanding that any public money of Alberta has been paid on account of any goods so sold or delivered."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to and upon so coming into force shall be deemed to have been in force at all times from and after the first day of September, 1935.
