## A BILL TO AMEND THE TAX RECOVERY ACT, 1929.

The amendment made by this Bill takes away all rights of redemption in the case of land in an improvement district which has been finally acquired and has been declared to be Provincial Land, and in the case of land which has been finally acquired in an area constituted under *The Special Areas Act*.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Tax Recovery Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1937."
- 2. The Tax Recovery Act, 1929, being chapter 39 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended as to section 20, by adding at the end thereof the following:

  "(3) Where any land in an improvement district has been
- "(3) Where any land in an improvement district has been finally acquired and has been declared to be Provincial land pursuant to section 3 of *The Provincial Lands Act*, or where any land in any area constituted under the provisions of *The Special Areas Act*, has been finally acquired, every right to redeem the same whether under this Act or otherwise, shall cease and determine."
- ${\bf 3.}$  This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
