A BILL TO AMEND THE STOCK INSPECTION ACT, 1922.

NOTE.

Section 2 of the Bill provides that the notification of shipments of live stock to extra-provincial points may be made either by mail or by telegraph instead of by registered mail. The section further provides that the provisions of section 7 shall not apply to stock shipped out of the Province through Edmonton or through Calgary, or to or through Winnipeg, but empowers the Minister to designate areas or shipping points as areas or points from which shipments to or through Winnipeg may not be made without complying with the requirements of the said section.

An Act to amend The Stock Inspection Act, 1922.

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Stock Inspection Act, 1922, Amendment Act, 1937."
- 2. The Stock Inspection Act, 1922, being chapter 69 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 7 thereof,—
 - (a) by striking out the words "by registered mail" where the same occur in subsection (1) and by substituting therefor the words "by mail or by telegraph"; and
 - (b) by striking out subsection (3) and by substituting therefor the following:
 - "(3) Unless it is otherwise ordered by the Minister, this section shall not apply to stock shipped out of the Province through Edmonton or through Calgary, or to or through Winnipeg.
 - "(4) The Minister may from time to time, by order under his hand published in *The Alberta Gazette*, designate any area or any shipping point or points in the Province, as areas or points from which stock may not be shipped out of the Province to or through Winnipeg, until the requirements of subsection (1) hereof have been complied with, and may vary or rescind any order so made; and every such order shall take effect upon the date of its publication in *The Alberta Gazette* or upon such later date as may be fixed in the order for the purpose."
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
