 \mathbf{H}^{IS} MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Companies Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1937."

2. The Companies Act, 1929, being chapter 14 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended as to section 13 by adding at the end thereof the following:

"(f) or to carry on any of the business usually or ordinarily carried on by a Stock Exchange or to provide the facilities for the marketing of any shares, stocks or other securities, of any company or corporation which are ordinarily and usually afforded by a Stock Exchange."

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 66 by striking out the words "with their appropriate numbers" where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof.

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
