# A BILL TO AMEND THE OLD AGE PENSIONS LEGISLATION ACT.

#### NOTE.

This Bill enables the Government to take advantage of the amendments made during the present session of the Parliament of Canada to *The Old Age Pensions Act*, extending the provisions of that Act to blind persons.

## BILL

#### No. 84 of 1937.

An Act to amend The Old Age Pensions Legislation Act.

#### (Assented to , 1937.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Old Age Pensions Legislation Act Amendment Act, 1937."

2. The Old Age Pensions Legislation Act, being chapter 7 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1931, is hereby amended as to section 2, by striking out the words and figures "Statutes of Alberta, 1927" and by substituting therefor the words "Statutes of Alberta, 1929".

3. The said Act is further amended by inserting therein immediately after section 2 the following new section:

"2a. In the event of the Parliament of Canada amending The Old Age Pensions Act, being chapter 156 of the Revised Statutes of Canada, 1927, in such a manner as to provide for the payment of pensions to blind persons, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may enter into any agreement which may be deemed necessary or proper for the purpose of making available to blind persons any pensions for the payment of which provision is so made, and may in the event and for the purpose aforesaid amend, vary or add to any of the provisions of 'The Old Age Pensions Act, Alberta,' in any manner which may be deemed necessary in order to make available to blind persons any such pensions."

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
