A BILL TO AMEND THE LOCAL TAX ARREARS  
CONSOLIDATION ACT, 1935.

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NOTE.

The amendment made by section 2 permits the municipality to charge a commission of 5% on collections of school taxes.

Section 3 rectifies a clerical error.

Section 4 authorizes the making of consolidation agreements in the case of arrears of taxes against any interest in crown lands to which the provisions of The Tax Recovery Act, 1929, do not apply.

# BILL

No. 95 of 1937.

An Act to amend The Local Tax Arrears Consolidation  
Act, 1935.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1937.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of  
the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta,  
enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Local Tax Arrears Consolidation Act, 1935, Amendment Act, 1937.*"

**2.** *The Local Tax Arrears Consolidation Act, 1935*, being chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1935, is hereby amended as to section 14 thereof, by striking out the last word of subsection (4) and by substituting therefor the following: "district, less five per centum thereof which the municipality shall be entitled to retain as its remuneration".

**3.** The said Act is further amended as to section 16 thereof, by striking out the words "municipal district" where the same occur in subsection (4) and by substituting therefor the word "municipality".

**4.** The said Act is further amended by inserting therein immediately after section 26 thereof, the following new section:

"**26a.** In any municipality in which this Act is for the time being in force, any person who has an interest in any crown land in respect of which there are taxes in arrears for more than two years, may enter into an agreement with the municipality for the consolidation of the arrears of taxes payable in respect of such interest as if he were the owner thereof and the land were not crown land, and all the foregoing provisions of this Act other than those relating to proceedings under *The Tax Recovery Act, 1929*, shall apply *mutatis mutandis* to any such agreement and the arrears of taxes to which the agreement relates".

**5.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
