An Act respecting Sessional Indemnities in respect of the Fourth Session of the Eighth Legislative Assembly and to amend The Sessional Indemnities Advances Act, 1937.

(Assented to _____, 1937.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. The provisions of sections 53, 54 and 55 of *The Legislative Assembly Act* shall not apply to the Fourth Session of the Eighth Legislative Assembly and the provisions of this Act are substituted therefor.

2. There shall be paid to each member of the said Legislature at the close of such Session the sum of two hundred dollars (\$200.00), which sum shall be deducted from the amount payable to him pursuant to the provisions of *The Legislative Assembly Act* for his attendance at the next ensuing Session of the Legislative Assembly.

3. *The Sessional Indemnities Advances Act, 1937*, being chapter 84 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1937, is hereby amended by striking out the words "the Fourth Session" wherever the same occur therein and by substituting therefor the words "the Fifth Session".

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
