An Act to amend The Judicature Act.

(Assented to _____, 1937.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Judicature Act Amendment Act, 1937 (Second Session)*."

2. *The Judicature Act*, being chapter 72 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after section 27*b* the following new section:

"**27c.** No action or proceeding of any nature whatsoever concerning the constitutional validity of any enactment of the Legislative Assembly of the Province shall be commenced, maintained, continued or defended, unless and until permission to bring or maintain or continue or defend such action has first been given by the Lieutenant Governor in Council."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
