An Act to amend The Ultimate Purchasers Tax Act.

(Assented to _____, 1937.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Ultimate Purchasers Tax Act Amendment Act, 1937."

2. The Ultimate Purchasers Tax Act, being chapter 7 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1936, is hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after section 13 the following new section:

"13a. The Lieutenant Governor in Council may from time to time by proclamation, suspend the operation of section 3 of this Act for such period of time as is fixed thereby as the period during which the said section shall be inoperative, and during any such period so fixed the tax made payable by the said section shall not be payable."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
