

# BILL

No. 4 of 1937 (Third Session).

An Act to amend The Male Minimum Wage Act.

(Assented to \_\_\_\_\_, 1937.)

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Male Minimum Wage Act, 1937.*"

**2.** *The Male Minimum Wage Act*, being chapter 76 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1936, is hereby amended as to section 5:

(a) by striking out the words "a minimum wage for employees" where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the words "a minimum wage for employees or different minimum wages for employees in different employments and in different classes or descriptions of any employment"; and

(b) by adding at the end of subsection (2) thereof the following new paragraph:

"(f) exempt from the operation of this Act or any order made thereunder any group, class or description of employees in any industry, business, trade or occupation."

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to and shall thereupon be deemed to have been in force at all times from and after the second day of November, 1936.
