An Act to Repeal The Legislative Assembly (Recall) Act

(Assented to , 1937.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Legislative Assembly (Recall) Act Repeal Act."

2. The Legislative Assembly (Recall) Act, being chapter 82 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1936, is hereby repealed.

3. The repeal effected by this Act shall relate back to the third day of April, 1936, and to every act done or right or liability accruing or accrued or incurred under the Act hereby repealed and to all proceedings in respect of any such act, right or liability; and any proceedings heretofore instituted under the provisions of the Act hereby repealed shall utterly cease and determine and shall be and become null, void and of no effect, as if the Act hereby repealed had never been enacted.

 $\ensuremath{\textbf{4.}}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
