A BILL TO AMEND THE TRADESMEN'S
QUALIFICATION ACT.

NOTE.

The amendment made by section 2 of this Bill empowers the Lieutenant Governor in Council to designate areas in the Province within which a tradesman may not carry on a designated trade unless he is the holder of a certificate of proficiency or to designate parts of the Province as excepted areas within which a certificate of proficiency shall not be requisite in respect of a designated trade.

Section 3 of the Bill is consequential on the foregoing amendment, and makes it an offence to engage in a trade at any place in the Province where such person is prohibited from carrying on such trade.

An Act to amend The Tradesmen's Qualification Act.

(Assented to _____, 1938.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Tradesmen's Qualification Act Amendment Act, 1938.*"

2. *The Tradesmen's Qualification Act*, being chapter 69 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1936, is hereby amended as to section 2 by striking out all the words in clause (a) commencing with the words "and prohibit" to the end of the clause and by substituting therefor the following: "and prohibit any person from engaging in any such trade in any designated area or areas of the Province, or in any part of the Province except any area or areas which are designated as excepted areas, unless such person is for the time being the holder of a subsisting certificate of proficiency in respect of the designated trade issued pursuant to this Act".

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 3 by striking out the words "engages in or follows any such trade" where the same occur therein and by substituting therefor the words "engages in or follows any such trade at any place in the Province where such person is prohibited from carrying on such trade".

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
