

Bill No. 25 of 1938.

A BILL TO PROVIDE FACILITIES FOR THE REHABILITATION AND ASSISTANCE OF PERSONS WHO HAVE BEEN AFFLICTED BY POLIOMYELITIS.

NOTE.

This Bill empowers the Minister of Health, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council to enter into agreements with the Board of any hospital which is equipped and has proper facilities for the treatment of persons who have been afflicted by Poliomyelitis (Infantile Paralysis), and who are suffering from the consequences thereof, providing for the reception, hospitalization, care and treatment in such hospital of such persons upon such terms and conditions as may be prescribed by the agreement.

The Minister of Health is further empowered with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council to make provision for the training and instruction of persons who have been afflicted by Poliomyelitis and who are suffering from the consequences thereof.

Expenditures incurred in the administration of this Act are to be met by such sums as may be voted by the Legislature.

An Act to provide Facilities for the Rehabilitation and Assistance of Persons who have been Afflicted by Poliomyelitis.

(Assented to _____, 1938.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Poliomyelitis Sufferers Act.*"

2.—(1) The Minister of Health, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, is hereby empowered to enter into agreements on behalf of the Province with the Board of any hospital which is equipped and has proper facilities for the treatment of persons who have been afflicted by poliomyelitis and are suffering from the consequences thereof, providing for the reception, hospitalization, care and treatment of such persons in such hospital upon such terms and conditions as may be prescribed in any such agreement.

(2) The Minister of Health, with the approval of the Lieutenant Governor in Council, is hereby empowered to make such provision for the training and instruction of persons who have been afflicted by poliomyelitis and are suffering from the consequences thereof, as he may deem of advantage to them.

3. Any moneys payable by the Province in respect of any agreement or any arrangement entered into in pursuance of this Act shall be paid out of such sums as may be from time to time appropriated by the Legislature for that purpose.

4. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
