An Act to amend The Public Highways Act, 1929.

**H**IS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

**1.** This Act may be cited as "*The Public Highways Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1938.*"

**2.** *The Public Highways Act, 1929*, being chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended by striking out section 24.

**3.** This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
