HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "The Public Highways Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1938."

2. The Public Highways Act, 1929, being chapter 53 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended by striking out section 24.

 $\ensuremath{\textbf{3.}}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
