- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Town Planning Act, 1929, Amendment Act, 1938."
- 2. The Town Planning Act, 1929, being chapter 49 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1929, is hereby amended by repealing the following sections, namely; section 8, section 9, section 10, section 11 and section 12.
