A BILL TO AMEND THE PUBLIC SERVICE ACT.

NOTE.

This Bill includes in *The Public Service Act* a provision for the constitution of a Joint Council to be known as "The Alberta Civil Service Joint Council", consisting of six members of whom half are appointed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council and the other half are appointed by The Civil Service Association of Alberta, with such functions as may be prescribed by Order in Council.

BILL

An Act to amend The Public Service Act.

(Assented to _____, 1938.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Public Service Act Amendment Act, 1938.*"

2. *The Public Service Act*, being chapter 7 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended by striking out section 23 and by substituting therefor the following:

"**23.** For the purpose of securing the greatest measure of co-operation between the Government in its capacity of employer and the members of the Public Service in matters affecting the Service, the Lieutenant Governor in Council may constitute a Joint Council, which shall be known as "The Alberta Civil Service Joint Council" and shall consist of six members, to be appointed as to one-half by the Lieutenant Governor in Council and as to the other half by the Civil Service Association of Alberta, and the Joint Council shall have such functions and shall conduct its proceedings in such manner as may be from time to time prescribed by the Lieutenant Governor in Council."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
