HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Unearned Increment Tax Act Amendment Act, 1938."
- 2. The Unearned Increment Tax Act, being chapter 32 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 3 by striking out the words "a tax of five per cent" where the same occur in subsection (1) thereof and by substituting therefor the words "a tax of ten per cent".
- 3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
