An Act to amend The Domestic Animals Act
(Municipalities).

(Assented to _____, 1938.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the
Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts
as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Domestic Animals Act
(Municipalities) Amendment Act, 1938.*"

2. *The Domestic Animals Act (Municipalities)*, being
chapter 25 of the Statutes of Alberta, 1923, is hereby amend-
ed as to section 14 by striking out the word "drive" where
the same occurs therein and by substituting therefor the
words "drive, lead, take or convey".

3. The said Act is further amended as to section 15 by
striking out the word "drive" where the same occurs therein
and by substituting therefor the words "drive, lead, take or
convey".

4. The said Act is further amended as to section 31 by
adding at the end thereof the following:

"Provided further that the poundkeeper upon the request
of any person whom he may reasonably suppose to be the
owner of two or more impounded animals, may release some
of the impounded animals retaining such as he deems to be
of a value sufficient for the payment of all damages, fees and
charges payable under the provisions of this Act in respect
of all such animals, and the animals so retained shall be de-
tained until all such damages, fees and charges have been
paid."

5. The said Act is further amended by inserting therein
immediately after section 37 the following new section:

"**37a.** Every person who makes in respect of any im-
pounded animal any unreasonable and unjustifiable claim for
damages or for the costs of impounding any animal, shall be
guilty of an offence and shall be liable on summary convic-
tion therefor to a fine of not more than ten dollars and costs
and in default of payment to imprisonment for a term of not
more than seven days."

6. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which
it is assented to.
