An Act to amend The Legislative Assembly Act.

(Assented to _____, 1938.)

HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

1. This Act may be cited as "*The Legislative Assembly Act Amendment Act, 1938.*"

2. *The Legislative Assembly Act*, being chapter 56 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended by inserting therein immediately after section 53 the following new section:

"**53a.** Notwithstanding anything contained in section 53 or in any other provision of this Act, an allowance of two thousand dollars shall be payable to each member of the Legislative Assembly in attendance at the Sixth Session of the Eighth Legislature who has attended at sittings of the Assembly or meetings of some committee thereof on at least ten sitting days of such Session."

3. This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
