HIS MAJESTY, by and with the advice and consent of the Legislative Assembly of the Province of Alberta, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Act may be cited as "The Judicature Act Amendment Act, 1939."
- 2. The Judicature Act, being chapter 72 of the Revised Statutes of Alberta, 1922, is hereby amended as to section 48 by striking out the words "within one month", where the same occur therein, and by substituting therefor the words "within ten days".
- $\ensuremath{\mathbf{3.}}$ This Act shall come into force on the day upon which it is assented to.
